FAQs

Questions regarding Selection / Nomination

- Q Is there a cap on the number of athletes that can be selected in the Athletics contingent of Team Wales?
- A Yes. Athletics can only select a maximum of 5 athletes to represent Team Wales at the Commonwealth Youth Games.
- Q If an athlete achieves a qualification standard does this mean that they will automatically be **selected**?
- A No. If an athlete achieves the qualification standard in the qualifying period, they will be **considered for nomination**. Because of the cap on the number of athletes who can be selected, it is not guaranteed that an athlete who has achieved the qualification standard will definitely be nominated or selected. All nominations, are subject to the final selections made by Commonwealth Games Council for Wales (CGCW).
- Q Will I be able to appeal my non-nomination?
- A Yes. All details about the appeals process are contained in the nomination policy document.
- Q How old do you have to be to compete at the CWYG?
- A Only athletes born in the years 2000 and 2001 can be considered for selection.
- Q What competition support will be available for athletes during the qualifying period?
- A Welsh Athletics will endeavour to provide appropriate competition opportunities for u18 athletes, together with the other home countries, in the lead up to the qualification deadline.

Questions regarding the team's time in the Bahamas

- Q What will be the weather conditions at the time of the Games in the Bahamas?
- A Low to mid 30 degrees Celsius, high humidity with high chance of heavy showers and storms.
- Q Will personal implements for throwers be taken to the Bahamas?
- A Yes – if required.
