Summary of changes - the Byelaws of Welsh Athletics

Proposal 1

To accept multiple changes throughout the document where executive job titles have been updated i.e National Coach to Head of Performance.

This ensures accuracy of roles and membership across various committees and task groups.

Proposal 2 – byelaw 2.5 – registration

- 2.5.2 Athletes who are members of a Club affiliated to Welsh Athletics Ltd register through the relevant affiliation process.
- 2.5.4 Coaches, officials (both technical and non-technical), team managers and volunteers must register through the relevant licensing scheme in order to ensure that they are covered by the Company's insurance policy.
- 2.5.5 All athletes, licensed coaches, licensed officials (level 1-3), and all other club volunteers must adhere to the relevant codes of conduct, Anti-Doping regulations and all other codes of practice as part of their registration with the Governing Body (be it direct or via a club).

The above changes are aligned to changes to the articles and a recent review by UK Anti Doping.

The introduction of the term 'relevant affiliation process or scheme' would enable future changes to the club and member affiliation process. The introduction of byelaw 2.5.5 also reinforces the direct link for all members to the codes of conduct, codes of practice and Anti Doping regulations.

Separate Proposal – byelaw 16.1 – eligibility criteria

Introduction of additional byelaw proposing the introduction of eligibility through grandparents – this is proposed through a separate notice of motion
