MATTERS ARISING FROM LAST MEETING (ref. 13th JUNE 2018)

- IR Champs still no application from a race. Committee suggest that the advert is put on the website again. AD updated the committee today that a site at Llandrindod Wells has been identified, the course is over four fields and free access has been given for the use of the fields. The bottom fields are flat for the younger athletes, the two upper fields are hillier for the older age-groups. Car parking will be shared on various sites which will be slightly more complex, but up to 500 cars can be parked within about 500-800m of the site. DP will do some groundwork prior to the event. The Showground can't be used at Builth as the favoured course is unavailable and too much concrete would have to be used. The Committee agree that Llandrindod is to be the venue of the IR for 2018. Regional reps to inform the regions
- SJ and CJ were to attend a schools' meeting SJ updated that various issues must now go to the AGM before any changes can be made, so the Inter-Schools will have to continue as a standalone event in November at Brecon and not be incorporated in the IR at Llandrindod, as was originally hoped

CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED

- Confirmation received that Martin Green is the North Wales Road/Cross committee regional representative. SL has invited him to attend or be available via conference call or Skype for this meeting
- PB has asked if a Welsh team(s) will be at the Inter Area match held within the Telford 10K 9 Dec. NW sent a team last year. SL forwarded email to CJ to respond 28 Aug. CJ wishes the matter to be discussed at the meeting, with the proposal that either separate regional teams or one IR team is sent to the event, if the Committee agrees. A standard time would need to be set (race elite standards are sub 31 and sub 36 M/F) if a Welsh team was to be sent and regions informed so that athletes can be selected. CJ proposes regional leads receive expressions of

KT GF MG PS interest and that PB co-ordinates/ supports regional teams. Committee to decide. The Committee discussed the fact that the timing of the race is not ideal as it's the day after the IR XC and it's hoped that the IR XC will be well supported by athletes across the regions. MG confirmed that the North will send a team as not all will travel to the XC but the Committee agreed that no other region will, so that regional teams are not affected for the IR XC. MG will report to PB

- CJ also proposes a team be sent to Leeds, this is on 4 November so would need to be advertised soon. The Committee thought it was a bit late to advertise for a team now. It also clashes with the Richard Burton 10K, therefore another 10K representative opportunity will be offered at a later date
- PB has asked if the Masters WA Championships will be held within the Snowdon Marathon in October. SL emailed AD and JW to check. This was confirmed. Apart from the marathon all other Masters road events are included within senior Welsh Champs. Athletics are overseen by Welsh Masters, a separate body. JW suggested that WA would set up a sub-committee to oversee Masters events. The Committee doesn't wish the Welsh Masters Association to be a part of Welsh Athletics as there are complications, including the fact that South West of England are included. Should a sub-committee be formed, CJ would have to be involved as the money would be coming from the road/xc budget. AD suggests the Masters Champs remain as they are within the Senior Champs, however perhaps a subcommittee/ a working group with certain individuals is put together to put some proposals forward, in order to offer more opportunities for Masters. Perhaps more media coverage could also be used to promote events for Masters. JW to confirm which direction he wants to go, SL to email him
