



Trafford 10km Sunday 5th March – Trafford, England Selection Policy published December 2022

Overview

The Trafford 10km will take place in Trafford, England on Sunday 5th March 2023. This provides senior athletes with the opportunity to compete against a high-quality **British** field. Welsh Athletics continues to value **representative** competition opportunities and the role it plays in developing Welsh athletes.

Selection Policy Aim

The selection panel will attempt to select the best team possible to represent Wales.

Athlete Eligibility

To be considered for selection, athletes must be eligible to compete for Wales through at least one of the following:

- 1. Birth
- 2. Parentage
- 3. Retention
- 4. Residence (minimum 3 years)

Competition Format

The Trafford 10km provides **Senior Age Group** competition opportunities.

Teams of up to **4 Senior Men and 4 Senior Women** may be selected. Wales will compete against regional teams from across the United Kingdom.





Selection Criteria

For consideration for selection, athletes must have achieved the following qualification standards:

Senior Female	Event	Senior Male
35:00	10km	30:20

Qualification standards must have been achieved between 00:00 (GMT) 30th January 2022 and 00:00 30th January 2023 (GMT)

Qualification standards must be achieved in competitions organised or authorized by World Athletics, its Area Associations or its National Member Federations (Road performances apply)

Selection Process

The selection meeting will take place on **Tuesday 31**st **January 2023** and the teams will be announced on **Saturday 4**th **February 2023**.

The Selection Panel will comprise of 2 individuals nominated by the Welsh Athletics Road and Cross Committee, a team manager and 2 individuals from the Welsh Athletics performance team.

There is no automatic selection for this event. In coming to its decision, the **Selection Panel** will consider the following criteria (in no priority order):

- 1. 2022 and 2023 form and fitness in road 10km races
- 2. Evidence of competing at road 10km races in previous seasons
- 3. Current form, fitness and competition history (from 1st September 2022 to 30th January 2023)
- 4. Future potential and associated progression / development
- 5. Head-to-head competitive records
- 6. Previous / other event championship performances
- 7. Injury status
- 8. Athletes who are supportive of Welsh Athletics
- 9. Any other factors that, in the panel's opinion, give Wales the best chance of success





There shall be no right of appeal to Welsh Team selected by the Selection Panel.

De-Selection Process

De-selection of an athlete may occur following:

- 1. Failure to adhere to the Welsh Athletics athlete code of conduct
- 2. In the event of an athlete sustaining an injury or illness following acceptance of their position on the team, they are required to inform the team leader immediately. If it is deemed that the injury or illness will negatively affect the athlete's performance this will result in de-selection.

Equal Opportunities

Welsh Athletics is committed to offering equal opportunities to all athletes in Wales. Any Welsh athletes will be considered as part of the selection process, providing they have met the criteria that is laid out within this policy. Welsh Athletics will not discriminate in the selection of any athlete on the basis of any protected characteristics.
