Welsh Athletics Selection Policy for England Throws Camp's Throws Fest at Moulton College Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4th September 2022

Overview

Welsh Athletics will support a team of U18, U20 and U23 athletes to compete at the England Throws Camp's (ETC) Throws. Athletes invited will be part of a home countries select team. This reflects its aim of getting representatives across all event groups and disciplines at all age group major events and international teams.

A maximum team size of 8 athletes will be confirmed for the event.

The ETC Throws Fest opportunity will therefore be aimed specifically at athletes who the selection panel ("the panel") believes are showing realistic progression towards future age group major events and international team selection.

The standards for consideration for selection are

The selection panel will meet on the 27th of July 2022.

Eligibility

- Athletes must be eligible to compete for Wales to be considered for selection and hold a full British passport.
- U18 Only athletes aged at least 16 (sixteen) and not more than 17 (seventeen) years on 31 December 2022 (born in 2005 and 2006) may participate.
- U20 & U23 as usual age ranges

Events

- To maximize the opportunity for athletes to learn about championship competition, they will have the chance to compete on both Saturday 4th September in a simulated qualification competition with a maximum of 3 throws and again on Sunday 5th September in a simulated final with a maximum of 6 throws.
- Welsh Athletics will select a maximum team size of 10 athletes.

Selection Process

- The selection meeting will start take place on the 27th July 2022
- The final team will be confirmed no later than 10th August 2022.

The panel will select athletes who they believe satisfy the following criteria:

- Athletes that have met the distances standards as outlined above. If an athlete is not able to
 throw the U18 weight implement before the selection meeting but the panel deem they
 have the potential to meet the standard, the athlete will be considered.
- Athletes who demonstrate the potential to qualify for and medal at future age group major events and international teams
- Athletes who demonstrate current competitive form (by throwing at a UKA permitted event [UKA level 2 permit as a minimum] between 1st January 2021 and 18:00 on 26th July 2022
- Athletes who demonstrate a clear plan and rationale for attending the ETC Throws Fest, via communication with Ryan Spencer Jones – NTDC Throws

Other Information

- Athletes will be invited to meet at Moulton College on the evening of Friday 3rd September and stay through to the close of competition on Sunday 5th September. Athletes will be given full board and be supported by Welsh Athletics Staff
- Welsh Athletics will not be providing transportation to and from the competition venue and accommodation
- England Athletics will not provide financial assistance for travel to and from the competition.
- Welsh Athletics will provide a competition vest and/or t-shirt if not already provided in 2022.
