To be considered for a Welsh Schools' Team athletes must be in
school/college in Wales or registered with an Education Authority in Wales.
Welsh Schools' Athletics Association will select the following teams to
compete at the SIAB Cross Country International Fixture:
 8 Junior Boys and 8 Junior Girls (School years 8 and 9) – Individual
Race
 8 Middle Boys and 8 Middle Girls (School years 10 and 11) –
Individual Race
 2 Junior Boys and 2 Junior Girls – Mixed Relay
 2 Middle Boys and 2 Middle Girls – Mixed Relay
Reserves will be selected for all races, with a boy and girl reserve selected for
both relays.
The selection committee will meet Thursday 29th February after the Welsh
Schools' Cross Country Championships on Wednesday 28th February 2024.
The team will be announced on Tuesday 5 th March 2024.

Selections will be based on the following:
Individual Races:
 First 6 at the Welsh Schools Cross Country Championships (to be held
at Brecon on Wednesday 28th February) to be automatically selected
in the Junior and Middle teams

	The final 2 places for the Junior and Middle will be selected from current form at the following races:
	 Performances at the Welsh Inter-Schools/Inter Regional Championships in Newtown on 18th November, Welsh Athletics Cross Country Championships in Brecon on 17th February and the Welsh Schools' Cross Country Championships in Brecon on 28th February
	Mixed Relay Races:
	 Winner of the Welsh Indoor 1500m U15 (on weekend of 27-28th January) and U17 Championships (on weekend of 3-4th February) to be automatically selected in the Junior and Middle Mixed Relay teams respectively
	 Excluding the winner of the Welsh Indoor 1500m Championships, the top Ranked Indoor 1500m U15 and U17 athletes in 2024 on date of the selection meeting to be automatically selected in the Junior and Middle Mixed Relay teams respectively
	For athletes who meet the criteria for selection in both the individual race and the mixed relay race, if they have demonstrated the potential to achieve a top 8 finish in the individual race they will be selected for that race (unless they state before the selection meeting they would prefer to compete in the
	mixed relay). If not, they will be selected for the mixed relay.
Athlete	Athletes will be notified of their selection within 24 hours of the Selection
Notification:	Meeting.
Appeals Process:	There shall be no right of appeal to the selection of the Welsh team made by the Panel.
De-Selection	De-selection of an athlete may occur following:
Process:	 Failure to adhere to the Welsh Schools' and Welsh Athletics Code of Conduct
	2. In the event of an athlete sustaining an injury or illness following acceptance of their position on the team, they are required to inform the team leader immediately. If required, evidence will have to be supplied. If it is deemed that the injury or illness will negatively affect the athlete's performance this will result in deselection
