CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED

- Jamie Clode emailed information that committee meetings can now be held in a face to face setting, provided that a 2m social distancing is kept between participants. The option of joining the meeting online must also be present
- PS would like WA to outline guidance and license requirements for cross country leagues. His understanding is that there is no limit to entry numbers, however social distancing must be in place at start and finish, although during the race it's not necessary. Clarification for Clubs and Leagues needed: further to latest Welsh Government announcement, there is no requirement to social distance and numbers are open, provided race provider's risk assessment reflects the changes

PERFORMANCE TEAM PRESENTATION

• JW and AP presentation: Governance Plan, WA strategy, focus on what WA needs to achieve over next 7 years. JW to circulate to committee. Need for WA and Committee's aims to align. Representation opportunities for Road and Cross Country, 2x 5K, 2x 10K, 1x 1/2 marathon; Cross: Liverpool, Celtic, SIAB, Home Countries. CJ confirmed individual plans and opportunities for elite athletes, which sit outside the representative opportunities for that level just below elite. AP states that working with Committees is important, he wants a post international review to see how the event went and whether it's worth going next year. AP suggested that all selectors should be aware of individual athletes' performance and fitness and come to selection meetings informed. Responsibility for Budget sits with

- Exec committee, AP allocates monies to various Committees to support their planned programme of events but bookings etc made by WA.
- Questions were asked after the meeting, PS mentioned the blurring between volunteers and paid members, SJ raised the issue of governance and how there is some drifting from the bye laws, JW is aware of the need to change some things. SL queried the 'athlete individual plan' which was clarified as pertaining to elite level only
- RLP gave some information on competition programme to clarify championship dates. 5K Champs is within the Cardiff 5K, 10K Champs meant to be within the Cardiff Bay 10K on 26th September, Committee needs to decide on the venue for a Half Marathon Championships. Rhiannon suggesting a Cross Country Relay, as per JT idea, if the cross country season doesn't go ahead as planned. WA final Pembrey 5K 4th September, Rhyl 5th September. Possible WA 10K race on Friday 20th August at Bute Park. c.300 runners 'Sunset 10K'
